

Do you use SNAP (food stamps) and live in Colorado?

A research study at the University of Colorado Colorado Springs is interested in talking to Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program participants. This is also known as “SNAP” or “food stamps.” The study’s goal is to understand how SNAP participants feel about the program. And, how they feelings about law and policy changes impacting SNAP.



The study asks participants to take part in a 45-60 minute phone interview and fill out a short questionnaire. In exchange, participants get a gift card worth \$45.
