DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Pre-Requisite Courses for Pathway 1 & 2

All General Education Pre-Requisite Courses are required with additional courses noted for Pathway 2. Prerequisite courses and a Bachelor's degree (Pathway 1 only) in a non-Nursing field must be completed by the end of the fall semester prior to the summer for which student is applying. Courses (Pathway 1 & 2) and BS degree (Pathway 1) may be in progress while application is being submitted. Acceptance is contingent upon receipt of final transcripts showing all courses and Bachelor's degree successfully completed. Equivalent courses can be completed through another accredited institution of higher Education.
