

Opt-In/Opt-out of Clinical Nursing Education

The Department of Nursing (heretofore, the Program) at the University of Colorado Colorado Springs, in the Helen and Arthur E Johnson Beth-El College of Nursing and Health Sciences, is taking all necessary steps to insure a relatively safe and low-risk environment for all faculty, staff and students as we return to class sessions on campus and clinical education. The Program is following guidance from:

- American Association of Colleges of Nursing (AACN)

- Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE)

- University of Colorado Colorado Springs and University of Colorado System

As students and faculty return to campus to facilitate learning of hands-on psychomotor skills, it is necessary to implement procedures to prevent infection and spread of the COVID-19. It is appropriate to adopt principles of infection control for microorganisms that spread by respiratory droplet transmission. It is also important to remember that the virus may be spread by individuals who are asymptomatic.

Attention has been given to requirements and guidelines for cleaning, disinfecting, social distancing, appropriate PPE in different circumstances, containment, and extended illness.

Despite all planning and efforts, it is possible that some people may become ill and transmit the virus to other students, faculty, family, and friends. The Program will provide additional guidance to students around the need for staying home when ill, reporting illness, seeking assistance for absence, and obtaining additional support.
